

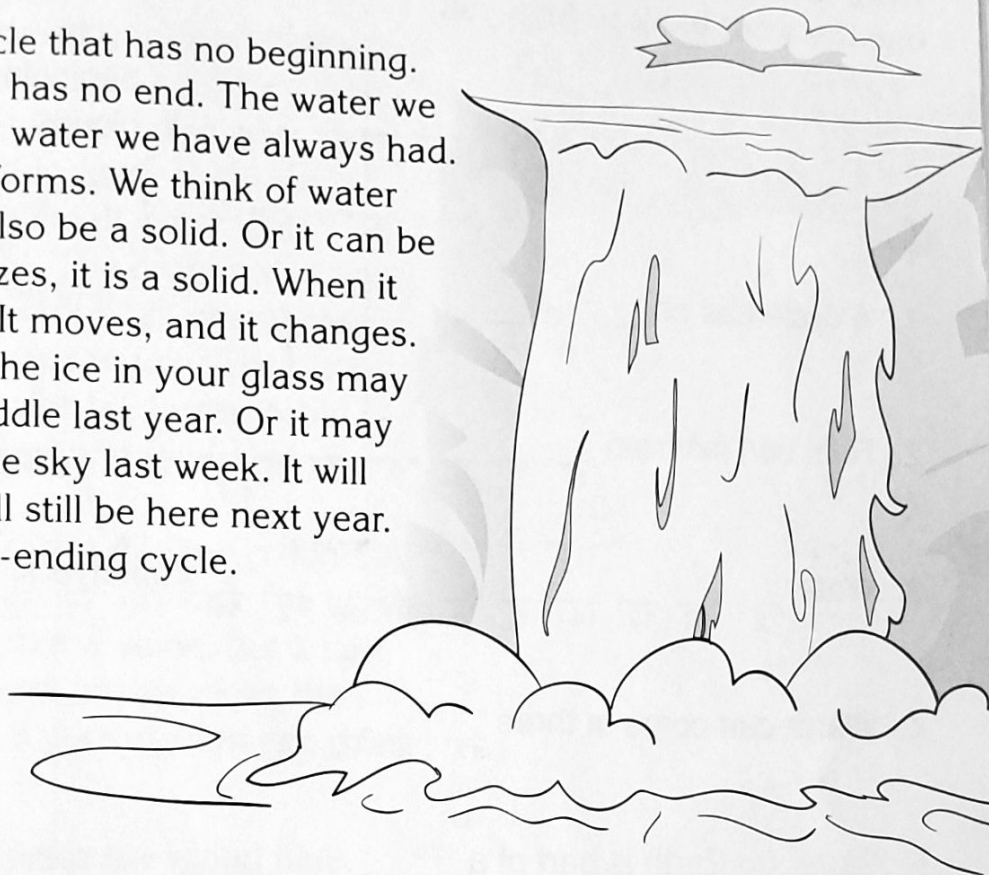
Round and Round

Or it may have been a cloud in the sky last week. It will change forms, but it will still be here next year. Water is part of a never-ending cycle.

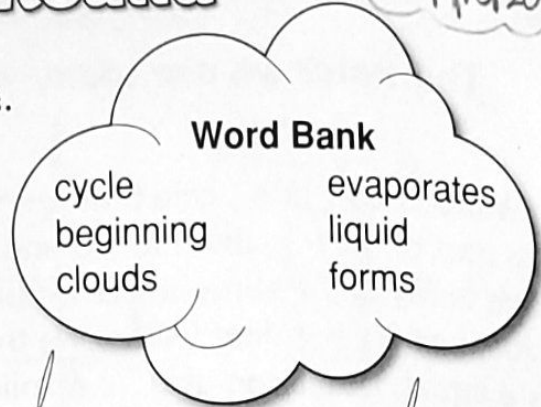
